- Q1. What is prayer?
Prayer is talking with God to adore Him, to thank Him, and to ask Him for what we need.
- Q2. What is sorrow for sins?
Being sorry for the sins we have committed and wanting never to commit them again.
- Q3. What is the Sacrament of Penance?
Penance is the sacrament by which sins committed after Baptism are forgiven.
- Q4. What is the Eucharist?
The Eucharist is the Sacrament of the real Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
- Q5. When did Jesus give us the Eucharist?
Jesus gave us the Sacrament of the Eucharist at the Last Supper.
- Q6. What did Jesus Christ do to save us?
To save us, Jesus Christ made up for our sins by suffering and dying on the cross.
- Q7. After His death, what did Jesus Christ do?
After His death, He rose from the dead.
- Q8. What is the Mass?
The Mass is the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, offered in our church by the priest.
- Q9. Why is the Mass offered to God?
The Mass is offered to God to worship Him, to thank Him, to make up for our sins, and to ask His help.
- Q10. When do the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus?
The bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus at the Consecration.

- Q11. What is necessary to receive Holy Communion?
To receive Holy Communion, you must be in the grace of God, believe it is Jesus you are receiving, and fast for one hour before.
- Q12. What did Jesus Christ do after his Resurrection?
After His Resurrection, Jesus Christ remained on earth for 40 days and then ascended to Heaven.
- Q13. Who is the Holy Spirit?
The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Holy Trinity.
- Q14. What is the Church?
The Church is the family of all baptized people.
- Q15. Who founded the Church?
Jesus Christ is the founder of the Church.
- Q16. Who is the Pope?
The Pope is the head of the Church, who takes the place of Jesus on earth.

Words to Know

Confession-Another name for Sacrament of Penance. It is the part of the sacrament where we tell our sins to the priest.

Absolution-The words said by the priest in the sacrament of Penance that take away our sins.

Consecration-The part of the Mass when the priest changes the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus.

Holy Eucharist-The sacrament in which Jesus comes to us in the form of bread and wine; the Body and Blood of Jesus.

Resurrection-When Jesus rose from the dead.

Ascension-When Jesus went back to Heaven forty days after Easter.
