The Knights of Columbus (Council 7011) is pleased to announce our 2017 4-Life Story Scavenger Hunt Contest. The following is a summary of the Terms and Conditions of this contest:

Guidelines:

- Contest is open to all students in grade levels indicated below.
- Story must be a real pro-life story, with sources indicated, and the presentation of the story must be the student's original work and be submitted by the published deadline.
- Story must be typed on 8 ½" X 11" paper one sided, double spaced, with one inch margins and be between 500 and 750 words long.
- The student's name, grade and contact information should appear only on the separate Contest form (attached) which should be stapled to the story.
- All entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus (Council 7011) and will not be returned. In addition, all pictures and videos taken by the Knights of Columbus (Council 7011) can be used by the Knights for their purposes.

- **Judging:**

- Judges will be selected by the Council 7011. Council members, clergy, teachers, and other members of the community may serve as judges.

- Stories will be judged on a 100-point scoring system as follows...

35 points: Content as to how clearly the story is presented.

30 points: Grammar-How well is the story is written with respect to sentence structure, paragraph construction and spelling.

35 points: Style-Does the story show creativity, imagination and development in a compelling style?

Sponsoring Organization:

Council 7011 is the sponsor of this contest and the Grand Knight of Council 7011 or his designate is the official responsible for this contest.

Awards:

Awards will be grouped as follows...

- Group 1- Grades 7-8
- Group 2-Grades 9-10
- Group 3-Grades 11-12

Awards will be as follows...

For each of the above groups,

- \$100 cash - first prize
- \$50 cash - second prize
- \$25 gift certificate to Faith @ Work - third prize
- All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation.
